



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 46 – 2025

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE LAPU-LAPU CITY RESCUE AS THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (ERT) OF THE LAPU- LAPU CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE

WHEREAS, Republic Act 10121, also known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, strengthens the country's disaster risk reduction and management system, and it provides a framework for disaster preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 10121 mandates the creation of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils at national and local levels, which are responsible for organizing and mobilizing emergency response operations;

WHEREAS, Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices are tasked with forming and training emergency response teams, including search and rescue units, medical responders, evacuation coordinator's, camp management team, and humanitarian relief teams, among others:

WHEREAS, it is essential to constitute the Lapu-Lapu City Rescue as the Emergency Response Team (ERT) of the Lapu-Lapu City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office in consideration of its vital role to manage incidents and disasters by acting swiftly and systematically to protect lives, property, and the environment;

NOW THEREFORE, by the powers vested in me by law, I, **MA. CYNTHIA "CINDI" K. CHAN**, City Mayor do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. CONSTITUTION OF THE LAPU-LAPU CITY RESCUE AS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (ERT) OF THE LAPU-LAPU CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE. The Emergency Response Team shall be composed of the following:

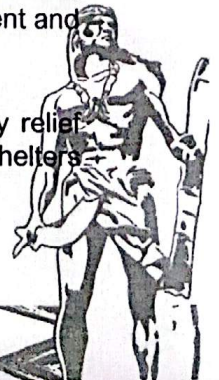

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS. The Emergency Response Team (ERT) of the Lapu-Lapu City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office shall have the following functions:

1. Immediate Response and Rescue: Lapu-Lapu City Rescue is the first to respond during emergencies by conducting search and rescue, fire suppression, administering emergency medical care and evacuating affected individuals;
2. Incident Assessment: Assess the situation to determine the scale of the disaster, identify hazards and safety concerns, and recommend appropriate actions.
3. Coordination and Communication: Lapu-Lapu City Rescue serve as a communication link between responders, local authorities, and the public to ensure accurate and timely information flow;
4. Safety Monitoring: Monitor existing risks (like fire, chemical exposure, or structural damage) and implement safety protocols to prevent and mitigate further harm;
5. Resource Management: Initiate the distribution of emergency relief supplies such as food, water, and medicine, and help manage shelters for displaced individuals;

6. **Support Recovery Efforts:** After the emergency response period had passed, it assists in cleanup, damage assessment, and help affected communities begin recovery; and
7. **Training, Exercises, and Simulations:** Lapu-Lapu City Rescue will train volunteers, conduct drills and exercises, and review emergency plans to ensure readiness before disaster happens.

SECTION 3. INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM (ICS). Lapu-Lapu City Rescue shall practice Incident Command System (ICS) to manage incidents and emergencies to ensure coordinated and efficient response operations. ICS is a standard, on scene, all-hazard incident management concept that is adopted by the Philippines thru RA10121.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless otherwise superseded or modified by subsequent Executive Orders and other issuances.

Let copies of this Executive Order be furnished to the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, City Budget Office, City Accountant's Office and the City Treasurer's Office for their information and guidance.
