



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 45 – 2025

AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CASH AND FOOD FOR WORK, TRAINING AND CARING FOR THE VULNERABLE SECTOR, COMMUNITY DISASTER VOLUNTEERS AND THOSE WHO UNDERGO DISASTER RISK REDUCTION & MANAGEMENT CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM OF THE CITY OF LAPU-LAPU

WHEREAS, the Philippine Government through the National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (NDRRMC) and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) implemented the Cash and Food for-Work, Training and Caring as pre-disaster program to help the vulnerable Filipino families prepare adequately before disaster strikes.

WHEREAS, DSWD implements the same as a social protection intervention program for the economically and disaster vulnerable population of the country.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction Management Act (Republic Act 10121), Climate Change Act (Republic Act 9729) and the Local Government Code (Republic Act 7160) mandates for a proactive and responsive local government in implementing the four (4) thematic areas in disaster risk reduction by executing PPAs that aim to build resilient communities.

WHEREAS, the City of Lapu-Lapu adopts the DSWD enhance guidelines on the implementation of the Cash and Food for-Work, Training and Caring for disaster risk reduction under Memorandum Circular No. 04 series of 2021.

WHEREAS, the City of Lapu-Lapu through its Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Fund have laid down PPAs that provide for Cash for-Work, Training and Caring

WHEREAS, Cash and Food for-Work is provided to qualified beneficiary in exchange of participated DRRM or community work

WHEREAS, Cash and Food for-Training is provided to qualified beneficiary in exchange of participated DRRM or community training

WHEREAS, Cash and Food for-Care is a specialized service intervention aimed to ensure utmost care to disaster vulnerable population while in displacement.

WHEREAS, Cash and Food for-Care is provided to individuals who are taking care of disaster victims such as children, elderly, the sick, Persons with Disability (PWD), pregnant and lactating mothers, mentally challenged persons while in evacuation centers or rented shelters among others.

WHEREAS, one of the PPAs in disaster preparedness is the stockpiling of Food Items (FI) composed of rice, canned goods, noodles, milk and coffee as required by RA 10121

WHEREAS, there is expiration on the stockpiled Food Items so that these perishable goods must be distributed to the target beneficiaries even without experiencing disaster or calamities through the Food for-Work, Training and Caring program.

WHEREAS, the about-to-expire Food Items can also be utilized as incentive for Blood Donors of the City Health Office Monthly Blood Letting or Donation program

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, **MA. CYNTHIA "CINDI" K. CHAN**, City Mayor of the City of Lapu-Lapu, Cebu, do hereby establish the enhance guidelines on the implementation of the Cash and Food for-Work, Training and Caring for vulnerable sector, community disaster volunteers and those who undergo disaster risk reduction management capability development program sub to the following conditions:

1. Any person, who is bona fide resident of the City of Lapulapu and who is undergoing disaster risk reduction and management capability development is qualified to be a beneficiary of this program.
2. Under this enhance program, a qualified beneficiary may perform any of the following activities:
 - a. Repacking, Transporting and Distributing Relief Goods
 - b. Transporting DRRM materials and equipment
 - c. Undergoing or participating DRRM training
 - d. Assisting during the conduct of DRRM capability development
 - e. Performing special care to disaster victims who are classified as vulnerable persons
 - f. Donating Blood
 - g. Responding to emergencies or disaster as community disaster volunteer
3. A qualified beneficiary shall be entitled to receive the prevailing daily minimum wage in Central Visayas for every day performance of the above mentioned activities.
4. A qualified beneficiary shall be entitled to receive One (1) box of Food Item for Two (2) days of Work, Training and Caring.
5. All expenses incurred for the implementation of the Cash for-Work, Training and Caring shall be charged against LDRRMF Account
6. All Food Items used in the implementation of the Food for-Work, Training and Caring shall be charged against stockpiled Food Items of the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office.
 - a. Actual withdrawal of the Food Items shall only be done if the relief food box is stored for more than three (3) months.
