



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 47 – 2025

AN ORDER DIRECTING THE PROVISION OF ALTERNATIVE LIVELIHOODS TO VULNERABLE SECTORS AND RESIDENTS OF THE REMOTE ISLAND BARANGAYS IN THE CITY OF LAPU-LAPU

WHEREAS, the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan highlights the need to reduce vulnerabilities and increase capacities of vulnerable sectors and underprivileged residents in remote areas through inclusive, rights-based, and gender-responsive strategies;

WHEREAS, one recognized strategy to increase the capacity of the vulnerable sectors and residents of remote areas is the offering of alternative income sources to help reduce their dependence on high-risk activities and lower their exposure to hazards;

WHEREAS, providing alternative livelihoods to vulnerable sectors and poor residents is a vital component of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) framework because it directly addresses the root causes of vulnerability and builds long-term resilience.;

WHEREAS, when people have stable, diversified livelihoods, they're better equipped to recover from disasters and empower communities to bounce back faster and avoid falling deeper into poverty after a crisis;

NOW THEREFORE, by the powers vested in me by law, I, **MA. CYNTHIA "CINDI" K. CHAN**, City Mayor, do hereby order the provision of alternative livelihoods to vulnerable sectors and residents of the remote island barangays in the City of Lapu-Lapu and to charge all expenses related thereto to Account No. 9998-05-02-99-080-2 of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) CY-2025.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless otherwise superseded or modified by subsequent Executive Orders and other issuances.

Let copies of this Executive Order be furnished to the City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, City Budget Office, City Accountant's Office and the City Treasurer's Office for their information and guidance.
