RESOLUTION NO. 17-0792-2025

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPRECIATION AND HIGHEST SALUTE OF THE 17TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF LAPU-LAPU TO MAYOR MA. CYNTHIA "CINDI" K. CHAN FOR HER DECISIVE, HANDS-ON, AND COMPASSIONATE LEADERSHIP BEFORE AND DURING THE ONSLAUGHT OF TYPHOON "TINO," AND COMMENDING THE CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE (CDRRMO), ALL FRONTLINERS, AND THE THIRTY (30) BARANGAYS OF THE CITY FOR ACHIEVING A ZERO-CASUALTY STATUS IN THE RECENT TYPHOON

WHEREAS, Typhoon "Kalmaegi," locally known as "Tino," struck various parts of the Visayas and Mindanao regions, bringing heavy rains, strong winds, and severe flooding that caused casualties, injuries, and widespread destruction of property and livelihoods;

WHEREAS, the City of Lapu-Lapu, together with the neighboring Cities of Cebu and Mandaue, and the Northern Municipalities of the Province of Cebu, were placed under Typhoon Signal No. 4 in the evening of November 3, 2025;

WHEREAS, under the decisive, hands-on, and compassionate leadership of Mayor Ma. Cynthia "Cindi" K. Chan, the City Government of Lapu-Lapu moved swiftly, guided by proactive disaster preparedness and response measures that ensured the safety and welfare of every Oponganan;



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WHEREAS, through Mayor Chan's clear command and coordination, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), together with the city's frontline offices, emergency responders, and barangay officials headed by the Liga ng mga Barangay President, Hon. Jasmine Marie K. Chan, carried out timely pre-emptive evacuations, continuous monitoring, and post-typhoon recovery operations;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Captains and officials of all thirty (30) barangays of Lapu-Lapu City demonstrated immediate action, vigilance and disciplined field coordination which helped deliver a zero-casualty status for our city during the disaster;

WHEREAS, such achievement has once again proven that when governance is rooted in genuine service to people, the safety and welfare of every Oponganton will always come first;

WHEREAS, the recent demonstration of unity, discipline and shared responsibility is a testament that when we are together, we are stronger;

WHEREAS, despite the challenges brought by Typhoon "Tino", the City of Lapu-Lapu remarkably achieved zero-casualties, an outcome made possible through the strong, hands-on, and compassionate leadership of the City Mayor and the united efforts of the entire City Government;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Annabeth D. Cuizon duly seconded en masse,

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to extend appreciation and highest salute of the 17th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Lapu-Lapu to Mayor Ma. Cynthia "Cindi" K. Chan for her decisive, hands-on, and compassionate leadership before and during the onslaught of Typhoon "Tino," and to commend the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), all frontliners, and the thirty (30) barangays of the city for achieving a zero-casualty status.
