RESOLUTION NO. 17-0756-2025

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY OF LAPU-LAPU UNDER A STATE OF
IMMINENT DISASTER DUE TO THE APPROACHING TYPHOON "TINO"
(INTERNATIONAL NAME: KALMAEGI)"**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) has issued multiple weather advisories and tropical cyclone bulletins regarding Typhoon "TINO" (International Name: KALMAEGI), which continues to intensify and poses a significant threat to the Visayas Region, including the City of Lapu-Lapu;

WHEREAS, the said Super Typhoon is forecasted to bring torrential rains, violent winds, storm surges, coastal flooding, and possible landslides, endangering the lives, safety, and properties of residents within the City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, Local Government Units (LGUs) are mandated to ensure the protection and welfare of their constituents by taking proactive measures before, during, and after disasters;



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2nd Special Session, 17th SP, Res. No. 17-0756-2025 Cont'd: - 2 -

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 12287 "An Act Establishing a Mechanism on the Declaration of State of Imminent Disaster, Providing the Criteria for its Declaration and Lifting, Enabling Anticipatory measures, and Appropriating Funds Therefor";

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every LGU shall exercise the powers necessary to promote the general welfare, particularly in situations that threaten the safety, security, and lives of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, such declaration will enable the immediate mobilization of response teams, utilization of local disaster funds, preemptive evacuation of at-risk communities, and prepositioning of food packs, relief goods, and medical supplies in coordination with all concerned agencies, barangays, and civic organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Marciano A. Alforque, Jr. duly seconded en masse,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby being resolved, to declare the entire City of Lapu-Lapu under a State of Imminent Disaster due to the approaching Typhoon "Tino" (International Name: Kalmacgi).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all departments, offices, and barangay disaster risk reduction and management committees (BDRRMCs) are hereby directed to fully activate their contingency and emergency response plans, coordinate closely with the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), and endure the safety, readiness, and welfare of all residents.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), the Office of the Civil Defense - Region VII, and all Barangay Councils within the City, for their information, guidance, and immediate compliance.
